Dayton Society of Artists Goes Virtual

Dayton, OH April 23, 2020 – Dayton Society of Artists (DSA) will be presenting their next exhibition, Intertwined, a national juried exhibition of fiber arts, online. In addition, the DSA is moving their workshops, artist talks, and other opportunities to zoom and is pleased to announce a database for searching for local visual artists.

After having to close the gallery doors for the time being due to COVID-19, the DSA quickly converted their art exhibitions to virtual formats. Their next exhibition, Intertwined, opens May 1, 2020 at 6pm. This exhibition will feature 32 fiber artists from around the US and unites their work in one space. The new virtual gallery will highlight the artwork by including high resolution images, so viewers won't have to miss intricate details such as the stitching of the piece. In addition, the gallery includes space for each artist's biography and statement of the art, links to the artists personal sites, so participants can explore their work further, and a shopping cart.
